March 24, 2011 Minutes
Crestline Neighborhood Association

President Sandra Storm called the meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Sandra did not tell us about the NUSA convention because we have not sent a representative in years. It was suggested that we write or email Kim Rafferty that she should hold her ground. Kim Rafferty is endorsing that 28 people be sent to the convention. The mayor must introduce a resolution, which will be voted on by the city council, at the Tuesday, March 1 meeting, for anyone to be sent to NUSA. Joyce Greathouse moved that we support the proposal to send one representative, to NUSA, from each community, if the community so chooses, plus five miscellaneous representatives, and each individual community must fund their own representative. Sherry Gill seconded the motion and the group voted unanimously in support. Secretary Barbara White will send an email to Ms Rafferty and Mayor Bell with copies to the City Council with this motion.

Parks and Recreation asked for \$250 to help fund the East Lake Park Family Fishing Rodeo. Barbara White made the motion and Joyce Greathouse seconded, the vote was unanimous in favor.

There is a March 5, 2011 workshop for neighborhood officers. Barbara White will attend.

Sherry Gill brought up the problem of speeding on Glenview. Mountain Brook has put in speed bumps on their part of the street. Birmingham says the street is a Mountain Brook problem. Sandra said she had been in touch with Don Lupo and Mr. Dawkins. They say Birmingham will not put in speed bumps because of EMT liabilities. Sandra suggested the residents get together as a group and stay in touch with authorities. Sherry said Chief Roper knows of the problem. Sherry will continue to pursue solutions to the problem. A three or four way stop sign might be a solution.

FLOYD IS BACK - call the police if you see him.

Jay Donmoyer from Eastwood says the CAB - Citizens Advisory Board- needs to be more involved with the neighborhood associations. Eastwood NA is working to replace the crepe myrtles along Crestwood.

The minutes from last month were amended to change the name Sarah Moler to Sarah McKay from Community Education South.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:34pm.
