Fire Station 26 was represented by Fire Lt. Fuller who is with Fire Investigation. He reported that there have been multiple kitchen fires from leaving food cooking on the stove and being left unattended. Please watch your stove. New smoke detectors are on order and will be available to the public for free.

East Police Officer Sentelle reported statistics on burglary and auto breakins. The robbery at WalMart was by a professional bank robber from North Carolina, who was caught almost immediately.
